“Auslan Services Foundation Grants are designed to support the signing Deaf community in Australia. When each application is reviewed, only consideration is given by the selection panel when there is clear evidence of this objective.”

The following list provides a clear guide to help you tailor your project so you have a better chance of being successful in your proposal...

- Your proposal must have clear evidence that shows support to the Australian signing Deaf community,
- Your project will be achieved by the use of Auslan in all face to face dealings with stakeholders,
- Your grant can cover the cost of your time to make the project happen
- Deaf people will be the sole beneficiaries of the project outcomes,
- Preference will be give to those applications that demonstrate positive outcomes to many Deaf people (not just 1 person),
- Collaboration with other organizations to deliver your project is important,
- Your project is innovative, catchy and is well promoted to relevant bodies,
- It is a good idea that when your project is finished, other Deaf people could use your idea and repeat it,
- Your project should have outcomes that are listed for us to see,
- You should provide a budget to show how \$500 will be spent,

The following list provides a clear guide of what your proposal should NOT include...

- Costs for travel of any kind,
- Purchasing of equipment,
- To be used for another scholarship or grant,

If you are successful and receive money to support your project, Auslan Services require the following from you....

- Progress reports on expenditure, project status,
- A final report with photographs or video clips so Auslan Services can use these for publicity of the foundation and inspire others to do the same,
